

Extension Installation

Handle Type: Kwikset® Entry



Because the set screw is reverse threaded, you must turn it COUNTER-CLOCKWISE in order to loosen it. Turn the set screw counter-clockwise until the handle can be pulled off.



Place a thin blade (such as that of a palette knife) behind the thumb turn lock. Use the blade as a wedge to pop off the lock.



Insert the THUMB TURN EXTENSION until it snaps into place.



Slide on the DOOR HANDLE EXTENSION. Line up the hole on the barrel of the extension with the set screw. Now turn the set screw CLOCKWISE until the extension is secure.



Install the thumb turn lock into the end of the door handle extension. Be sure to push the lock into the thumb turn extension.



Replace the door handle. Line up the hole in the handle over the set screw of the extension. Turn the screw COUNTER-CLOCKWISE until the door handle is secure. If the handle does not slide on completely, check to see if the set screw is catching. Otherwise, you may need to file down an uneven rib inside of the door handle.
