

Extension Installation

Hardware Brand:

Insert a thin rod through the hole at the base of the door handle. Push to release the handle.



After removing the handle, place a thin blade (such as a palette knife) behind the thumb turn lock shaft. Use the blade as a wedge to pop it out.



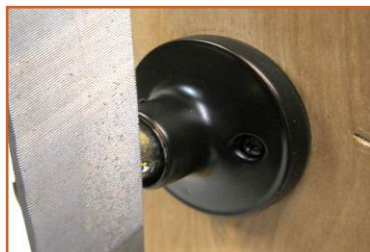
After removing the shaft, push on the ENCI EXTENSION. Move it around until the pin seats in the slot.



Using a #21 drill bit, drill a hole into the base of the extension for the set screw.



Remove the extension and finish drilling the hole.



Use a file to smooth the edges of the hole you just drilled.



Slide the STEM EXTENDER over the end of the lock pin.



Install the THUMB TURN LOCK SHAFT on the end of the stem extender.



Now push on the EXTENSION (as you did in STEP 3) and tighten the small set screw at the base of it.



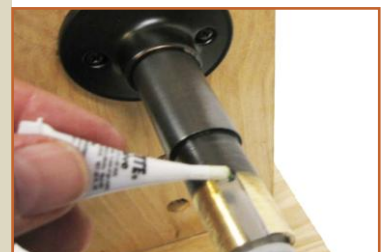
Carefully pull out the thumb turn lock shaft just past its second ring. Add *Loctite* adhesive to the set screw. Then screw it in until it is flush with the surface.



Push in the thumb turn lock until it hits the set screw.



Liberally add *Loctite* adhesive to both grooves on the end of the extension.



Slide on the door handle and let the adhesive set for ten minutes.
